How it Works

- When you submit your form, you may show for a two-month period, usually starting around the first of the month and ending a couple of days before the end of the second month. Dates may vary.
- Timely submission of your information and photos is required for our graphic artist to design images and signs for the display windows, social media, and other promotions and for the ARTery website.
- ARTery exhibit curators oversee art and handicrafts drop-off and pick-up process, make design decisions, and install artwork. They determine the size and number of works you can display depending on space, location, number of participants, and aesthetics.
- A potential customer at the window contacts an artist directly to arrange the sale and deliver.
- No sales take place at the location, except for the occasional weekend outdoor sidewalk sales in front of the location, where permitted. Artists usually fulfill orders at the end of the show. The ARTery does not charge a commission.
